We create our own cryptocurrency, the TUT token. The more you learn, the more money you get, the more relevant you are in the Community and the more visible you become to companies that may be interested in you.

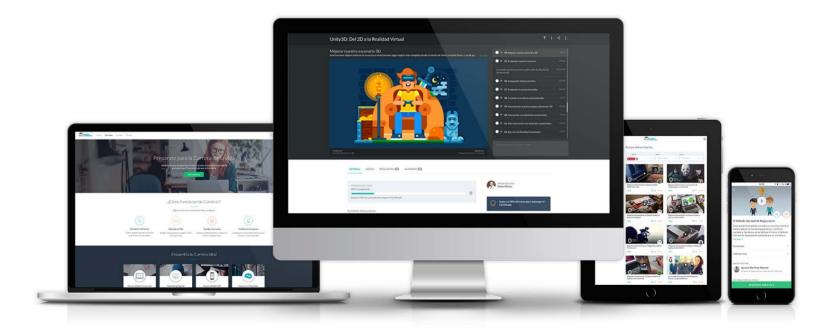

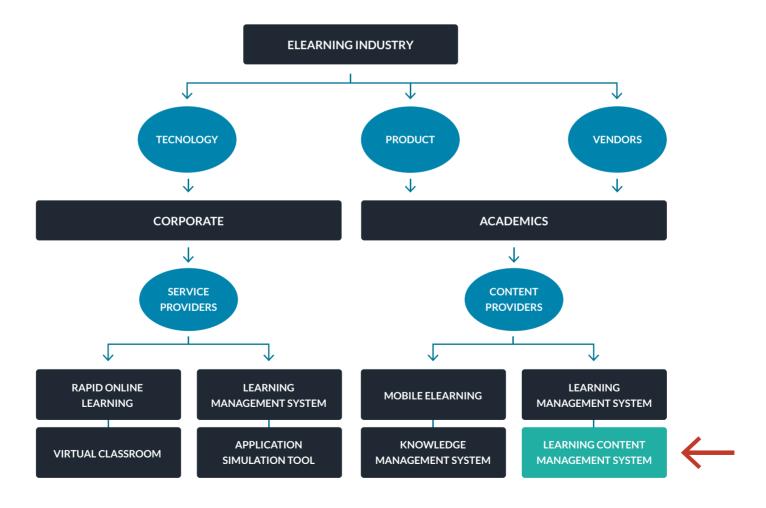

There are many business models (colaborative platforms, suscription services, LMS...), most of them come from traditional education and hold classical EdTech infrastructures with paid and free products.

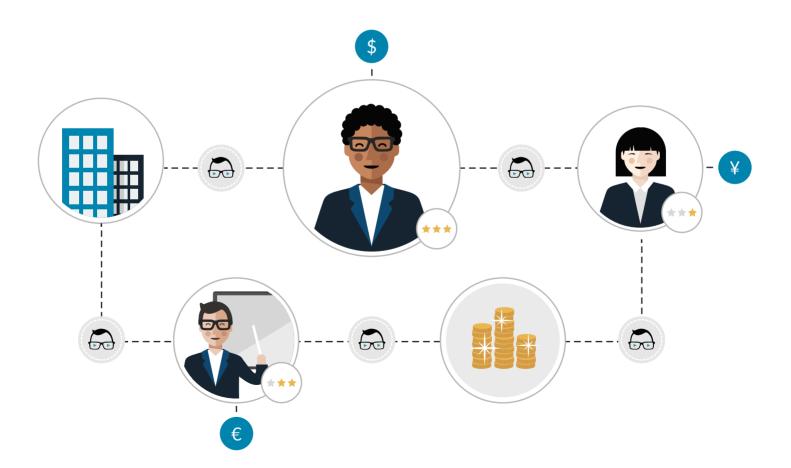

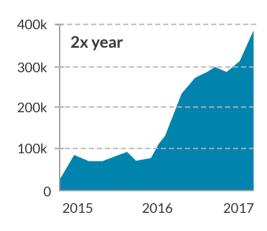




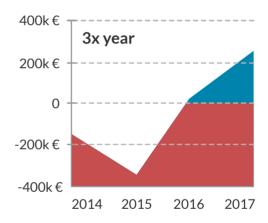
SCALING-UP OF TRANSACTIONS, USERS AND SALES



We have validated a Growth model, using these three main metrics, that would allow an exponential growing in the short-term, with the proper inversions.







Transactioned courses

We are closing to 100000 new courses transactioned per month. Web, Android, IOS... the number of people studying courses on-line is steadily increasing.

Monthly Active Users

While educational APPs have a lower TAD than social APPs, our frequency of use continues to grow.

EBITDA

We have found a sales scaling model that proves the profitability of our business model, generating even Cash Flow since 2017.
